




THE ELEPHANT EFFECT

Volevatch, the bathroom metalsmiths with Living Heritage Company (EPV) status, is adding the Jaipur series to its existing collections. Jaipur is named after the capital of the Indian state of Rajasthan and references both its palaces and its sacred bestiary in which the elephant symbolizes Ganesh, the god of prosperity. This mammal is venerated for its wisdom, strength and power – a key source of inspiration for our Jaipur series. This limited-edition series has been designed, shaped and refined, all by hand, in Volevatch's Tully workshops in the heart of the Somme.

A REQUEST BY DECORATOR JACQUES GARCIA

Made to measure, at the request of interior designer and decorator Jacques Garcia, our Jaipur series was initially created to personalize the baths in a Mughal-style palace. The elephant head, revered as both an icon and an idol in India, was used as a model for inspiration – in either solid brass or bronze – to create a range of taps, showers, hand showers, mixer taps, cupboard handles, wall hooks, toilet paper holders and towel dryers, or a complete package which is Volevatch's specialty as a pioneer in the field. In fact, the first taps incorporating visible piping were made in the 1980s by Serge Volevatch, founder of the eponymous company, in response to a 'special order' by dancer and choreographer Rudolf Nureyev.

SHARING OUR KNOW-HOW

The precision and delicacy in the patterns are inspired by the elephant's head, an elegance seen in the shapes and curves as well as in the beauty of our brass finishes. The whole project was overseen directly by Jacques Garcia, resulting in meticulous, demanding, high-quality craftsmanship in which every step was measured, careful and assured. From the initial sketches, wood sculptures and creation of molds to the polishing, machining, carving, assembly and testing, nothing was left to chance. This unique know-how has been passed down through the generations in Volevatch's workshops since 1975.

A FAMILY STORY

It all started at the beginning of the 1970s in a Parisian workshop. Serge Volevatch, the ingenious sculptor and handyman, began giving a second lease of life to the old bathtubs he unearthed at flea markets. He restored them before adding custom-made faucets and fittings. Unbound and independent, he followed his instincts, pursuing his passion for design, craftsmanship, excellence and uniqueness.

In 1975 he founded Volevatch as a company, with the aim of laying down the foundations of knowledge and know-how in the field of bathroomware. His metalwork skills were combined with a desire to perpetuate the 'made in France' tradition by employing local artists and craftsmen in the company's workshops, located in Tully in the Somme region. Serge Volevatch passed this attention to detail on to his son. As a sculptor, Igor Volevatch also has a clear sense of design, of shape, of how our products are used on a daily basis.

Now the head of the family business, he is entirely focused on providing a beautifully-crafted product which combines excellence with extreme precision. These values immediately appealed to his wife, Nathalie Volevatch, who today runs all the commercial management aspects of the family business.


